ASSESSMENTS

<u>AIMSweb</u> - Kindergarten through second grade students are given AIMSweb benchmark assessments three times a year in ELA and Mathematics. Teachers use the data collected to plan for instruction and remediation.

<u>MAP</u> - Measures of Academic Progress is a computerized assessment completed two times a year by our second grade students in Reading and Math. Results are used to plan for instruction and remediation. Our most recent results show the following percentages of students scoring at or above the 50th%:

Grade	Reading	Math
2nd	85%	80%

Cog/AT and IOWA - These nationally normed tests are administered to our second graders each year to identify children for Berkeley County School District's Gifted and Talented programs. Students take these tests in November and results are received in January. This year, 16 students automatically qualified for the gifted and talented program for next school year. Additionally, 51 second grade students qualified for further testing.



CSU students worked with our teachers twice this year to make the WVP Family Curriculum nights a huge success! Students engaged in math and reading activities that could also be played at home to reinforce BCSD curriculum.
