Measuring Growth and Learning



To monitor each student's academic growth we utilize comprehensive data gathered from a variety of sources that will help us make informed decisions that will lead to increased results for every student. Multiple pieces of data give us a picture of the whole child to prepare for college and career readiness. Berkeley County utilizes universal screeners such as Pathdriver, DRA II and PALS. Goose Creek Primary will progress monitor our students utilizing Pathdriver and Benchmark Assessments from Fountas and Pinnell in order to make informed decisions for our students. We also utilize quick cycle assessments and manage data through an online management data base called Mastery Connect. Our teachers are knowledgeable with administering these tests and how to analyze the results to make informed decisions. Goose Creek Primary teachers participate in Professional Learning Communities weekly during which they collaborate on data analysis.
