Measuring Growth and Learning



To monitor each student's academic growth we use DIBELS – Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills and MAP – Measures of Academic Progress. MAP is a computer-generated, nationallynormed test which means it is taken in many states and allows us to use these scores to make comparisons with other students across the country. DIBELS measures are assessed several times throughout the year and provide a snapshot of student growth in reading skills over a period of time. Classroom participation and daily performance are also indicators of a child's growth and achievement.
