Student Achievement

To monitor each student's academic growth, we utilize comprehensive data gathered from a variety of sources that will help us make informed decisions and will lead to increased results for every student. Multiple pieces of data give us a picture of the whole child to prepare for college and career readiness. Berkeley County uses universal screeners such as AIMs web, DRA, Reading and Math Inventory, PALS, and SC state assessments. Goose Creek Elementary also uses benchmark assessments from Fountas and Pinnell in order to make informed decisions for our students. We analyze data from quick cycle and posttest assessments, and we manage it through an online database called Mastery Connect. Our teachers are knowledgeable with administering these tests and how to analyze the results to make informed decisions. GCE teachers participate in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) weekly during which they execute district priorities with common planning, common assessments, and effective data discussions.
