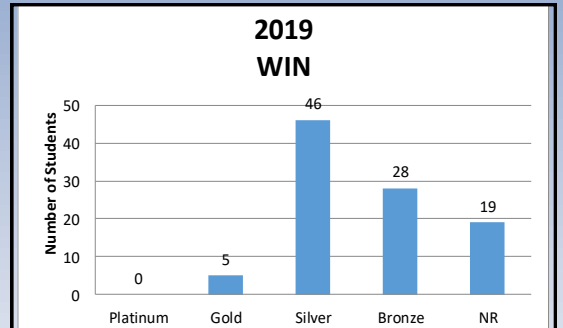
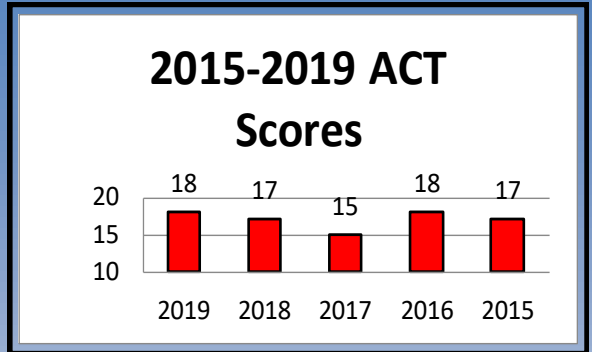

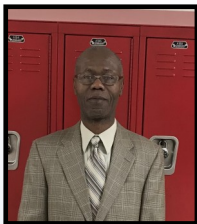
Accomplishments
