Proposed School Renewal Goals for 2012-2013

- ◆ **By the end of the 2012-2013 school year, 95%-100% of first graders will be able to read on grade level.**
- ◆ **100% of St. Matthews K-8 students will be assigned a faculty advisor and receive monthly individualized mentoring services. The advisement will decrease guidance and behavioral referrals by 85%.**
- ◆ **The percentage of students scoring met and above on state wide testing in all content area will increase by 3% each year from 2012 to 2016.**
- ◆ **By 2017, 100% of the teachers will score 80 or better on the state's technology assessment.**
