Proposed School Renewal Goals for 2013-2014

- By the end of the 2012-2013 school year, 95% - 100% of first graders will be able to read on grade level.
- * 100% of St. Matthews K-8 students will be assigned a faculty advisor and receive monthly individualized mentoring services. The advisement will decrease guidance and behavioral referrals by 85%.
- The percentage of students scoring met and above on state wide testing in all content areas will increase by 3% each year from 2011 to 2016.
