

OUR STUDENTS ARE COLLEGE AND CAREER READY

Savannah Singleton, Destiny Gordon, and Kamii Kornickey will receive their Associate Degrees from Trident Technical College.

17 of our seniors will complete a Career and Technology program and receive Microburst Employability certifications.

9 of our seniors will be a BioMedical Science completer with a certification in "Stop The Bleed" training.

21 students have received an NCCER Certification within their Construction class.

11 students have received an OSHA certification within their Barbering class.

75% of our students are anticipated to be College and/or Career Ready.
