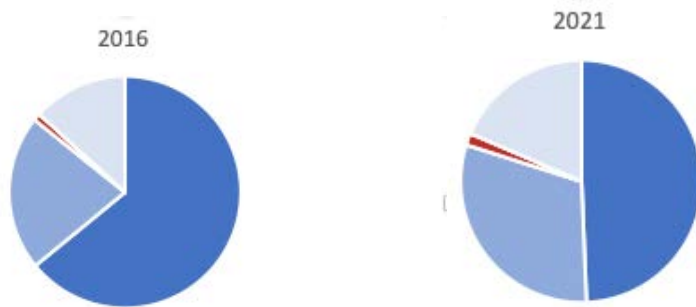
Student Enrollment
