

#### **School Achievements**

St. John's High School is home to over 300 students. Students at St. John's are among the brightest in the county, demonstrating proficiency and growth along their four years with us.

#### Highlights:

- 80% of parents who responded to the survey are satisfied with home to school relations
- 100% students served by 1:1 learning
- 69.5% of students graduated in 4 years
- 36.8% met the ACT Benchmark in English
- 8.8% met the ACT Benchmark in Math
- 22% met the ACT Benchmark in Reading
- 48.1% Completed the English I EOC exam with a C or Higher
- 59.8% Completed the Algebra EOC exam with a C or Higher
- 45.1% Completed the Biology EOC exam with a C or higher
