Also In the 7th grade, ELA SCPASS scores increased by 12 percentage points from previous year and increased by more than 20 percentage points in mathematics. (2014)

7th graders' social studies SCPASS scores increased by 23 percentage points and in science by more than 18 percentage points. (2014)
