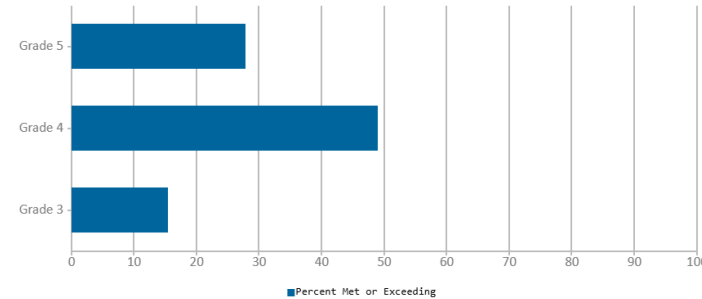
MISSION

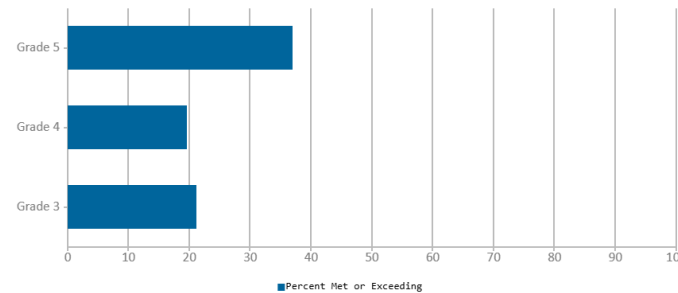
