





Kindergarten students take the Fastbridge earlyReading and earlyMath assessment three times a year. Due to Covid-related closures, students were only assessed during the fall and winter of the 2019-20 school year. Data indicates roughly 2/3's of

kindergarten students are considered at "low risk". This means that 2/3's of our kindergarten students leave Mary Ford ready for first grade.
