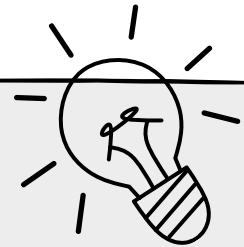
THIS YEAR AT GOODWIN

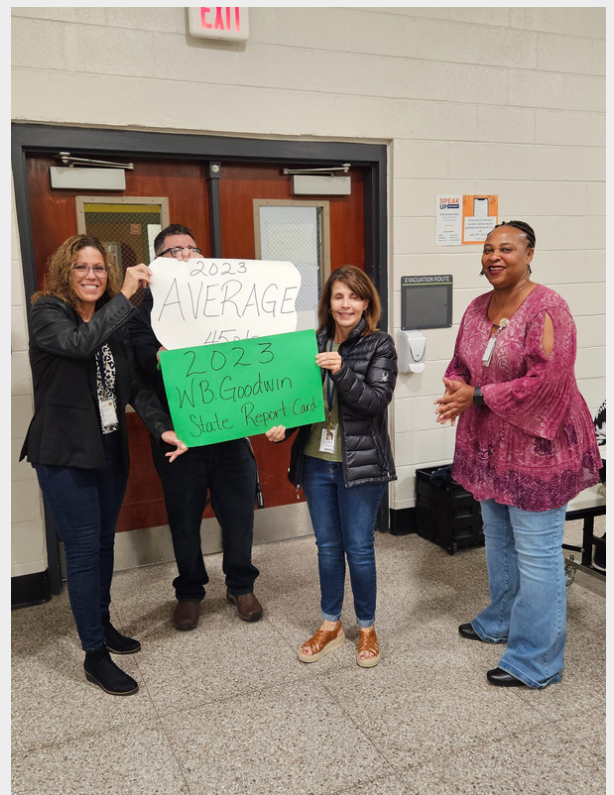
SCHOOL TEST SCORES SOAR!
