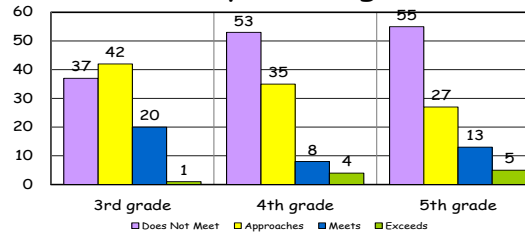

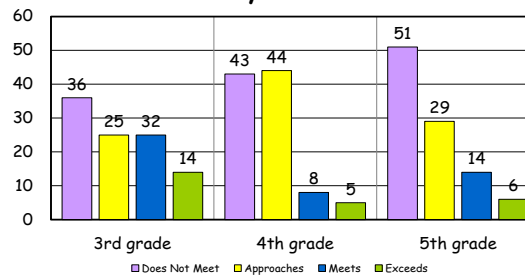

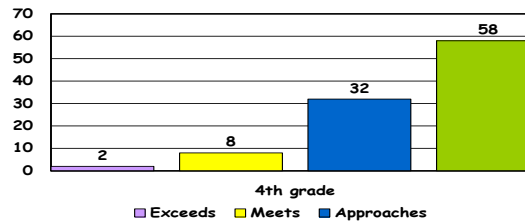
SC Ready Reading 2018



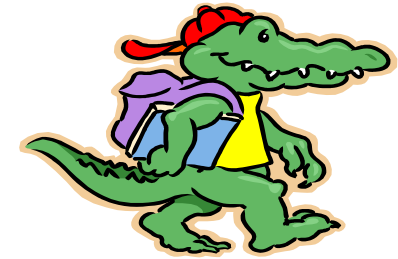
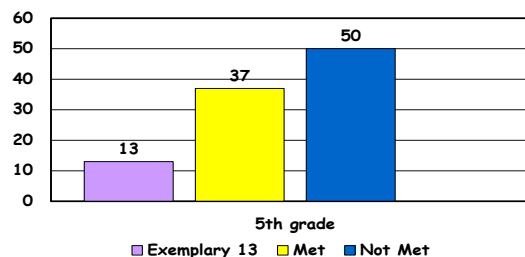
SC Ready Math 2018

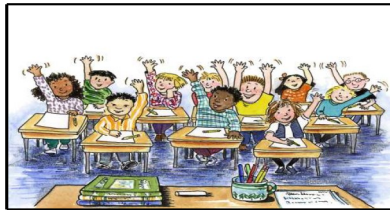
