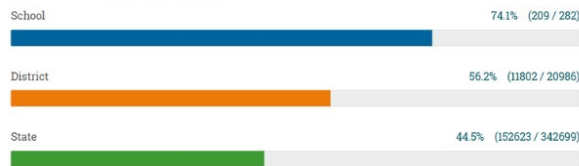


### Overall Student Performance
