Harbor View Elementary is a wonderful place for students to learn. With a population of over 600 students, we are able to offer a wide variety of activities and curriculum to challenge our students.

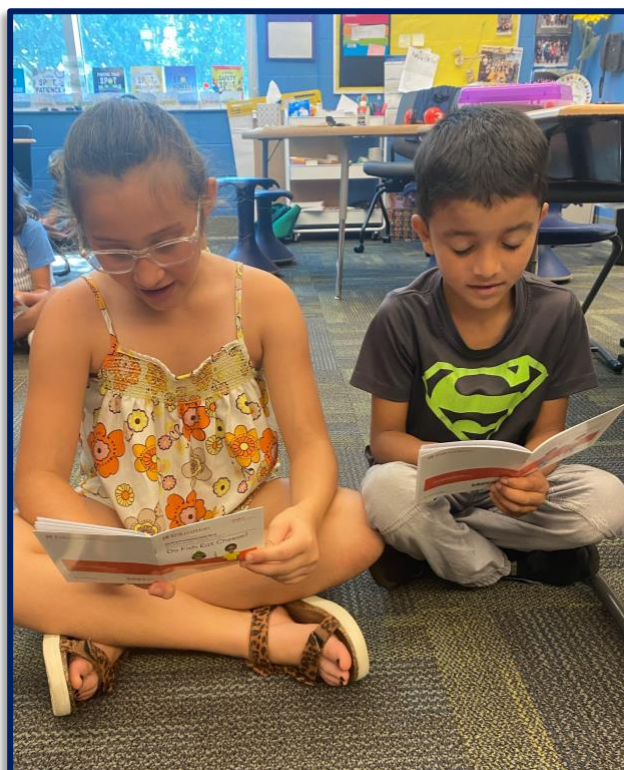

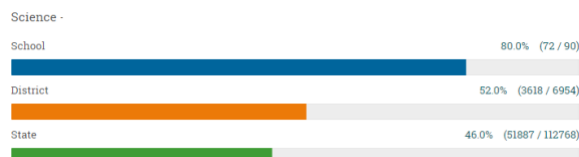
SIC Annual Goals
