The goal of the Advanced Studies Magnet is to provide students the opportunity to:

- Deepen knowledge of academic subjects in order to exceed challenging state academic standards.
- Utilize inquiry and exploration.
- Increase acquisition of marketable career, technological, and professional skills.
- Access a high quality, equitable education.
- Experience unique and personalized learning through a varied academic tract.
- Participate in a rigorous and expanded core curriculum in all four content areas.

Magnet Program Eligibility

- All Charleston County students are eligible to apply.
- Selection will be based on a lottery system from a dual pool of qualified candidates. One pool will consist of student within the Southwest attendance zone, and the other pool will be for students from other CCSD attendance zones.
- If accepted, students from outside the Southwest Zone of Districts 3, 9, and 23 must provide their own transportation.

Magnet Program Admissions Criteria

Eligibility criteria for the pool will include:

- A minimum GPA of 3.0 out of 4.0.
- Scores in the top quartile (75% or above) of a nationally accepted standardized assessment in both reading and math.

The magnet program of Advanced Studies will require:

- Parent and student contracts.
- Students to maintain a 3.0 GPA.
- Students to abide by the CCSD Code of Student Conduct and display exemplary behavior.
