



Hunley Park Elementary School is a growing success story of the




district’s work with personalized learning. Our students are directing their

The school serves approximately 560 students from Child Development to fifth grade. Approximately 74% of our students receive free or reduced lunch. All certified staff from Child Development to fifth grade are considered highly qualified teachers.
