Hunley Park Elementary School maintained its "average" rating on the South Carolina School Report card and work continues to achieve "good" next year, per the federal standards

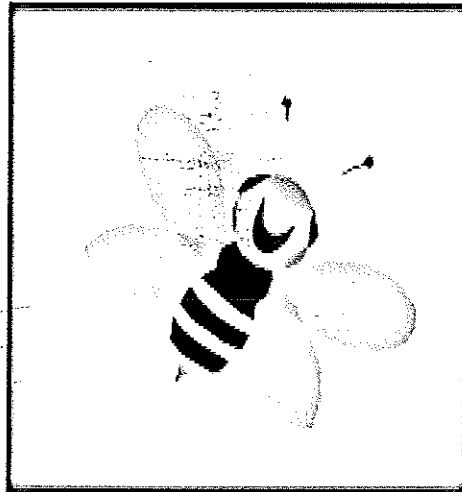

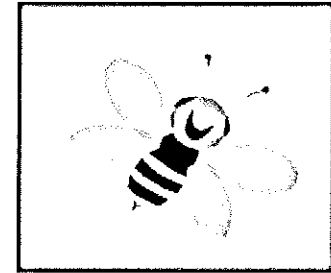

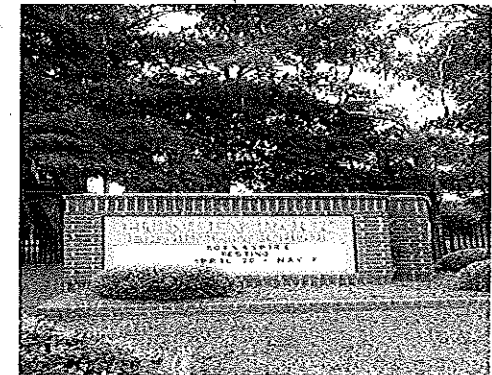


PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

Hunley Park Elementary School received an "absolute" rating of



average and a growth rating of average on the 2014 South Carolina

Annual School Report Card.

Overall 66.2% of Hunley Park's students received a score of met or exemplary on the 2014 PASS English/Language Arts assessment. 57.5% of the students received a score of met or exemplary on the mathematics assessment, 45.8% met or exceeded the standard on the science assessment, and 71.9% met or exceeded the standard on the social studies assessment.

Hunley Park Elementary School is a Title 1 School-wide program located on Dorchester Road in North Charleston, SC. We are a neighborhood school across the street from the Air Force Base. The school serves approximately 540 students from Child Development to fifth grade. Approximately 76% of our students receive free or reduced lunch. All certified staff from Child Development to fifth grade are considered highly qualified teachers.
