

Hunley Park's School Improvement Council is an action committee of parents, community leaders, and teachers striving to improve our school.





ACHIEVEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- Academically, COVID-19 made an impact on learning.
 SC Ready and SC Pass were not administered last year;
 therefore, only MAP data is available to measure
 student academic growth in grades 2-5.
- There were more students in grade 5 to meet their goal in reading and math.

2020-2021 GOALS

- At least 58 % and 54% respectively will score exemplary or proficient in English language arts, math, and writing on SCREADY.
- We will exceed MAP growth targets in both reading and math.

SIC ANNUAL GOALS

- Increase Parental Involvement: We collaborated with the parent advocate to provide three virtual programs to include educational activities. We also held movie night at the school with over 50 parents in attendance. Additionally, this year we had over 40 members enrolled in our Parent Teacher Organization. To further support our parents who need translation/interpretation services, we hired an ELL translator.
- Student Achievement: The SIC reviewed school data to identify the school's needs, create action steps and evaluate the school's plan. The SIC, along with the faculty and staff, reviewed the School Renewal Plan to ensure it addressed the areas in need of improvement.
- Support Positive Behavior and Students' Social-Emotional Learning: Community members on the SIC helped sustain our school store by donating items.
 Community members also contributed Thanksgiving dinners to those families in need.
