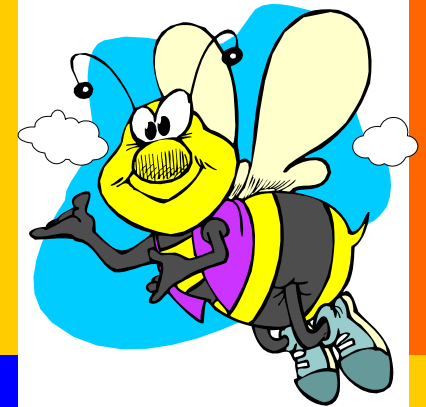

# Positive Behavior Interventions and Support

PBS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Support) is a process for creating safer and more effective schools. PBIS is a systems approach to enhancing the capacity of schools to educate all



children by developing research-based, school-wide, and classroom discipline systems. The process focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for

all students.

Hunley Park is the "Home of the Three Bees". The school wide rules include:

Be Respectful

Be Responsible

Be Ready to Learn

Our purpose is to learn, grow and become good citizens. The discipline program is designed to help create a climate of cooperation, academic excellence, respect, and safety at Hunley Park Elementary School.

## "Bee-havior Bees"

A bee-ticket is an incentive for students who follow the school's behavioral expectations. The purpose of the ticket is to promote positive interaction with students by every staff member. Students earn tickets by following the school's expectations and demonstrating the "Three Bees". At 2:10 each day, "Don't Worry, Be Happy" is played over the announcement system and one bee ticket is drawn from the basket. This student receives the "Good Bee-havior" bee pin and has their picture taken to display on the hall bulletin board.

## "Bee-havior Bonus"

Throughout the week, staff members will reward students who have been exemplary in following our behavior expectations with a "Bee-havior Bonus". These certificates are redeemed on Friday between 12:30 and 1:00. The students are greeted by the principal or other school official who will read and sign the bonus, congratulate the student and give the student a special treat.
