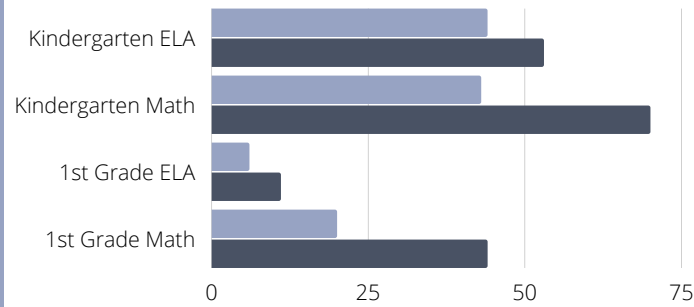

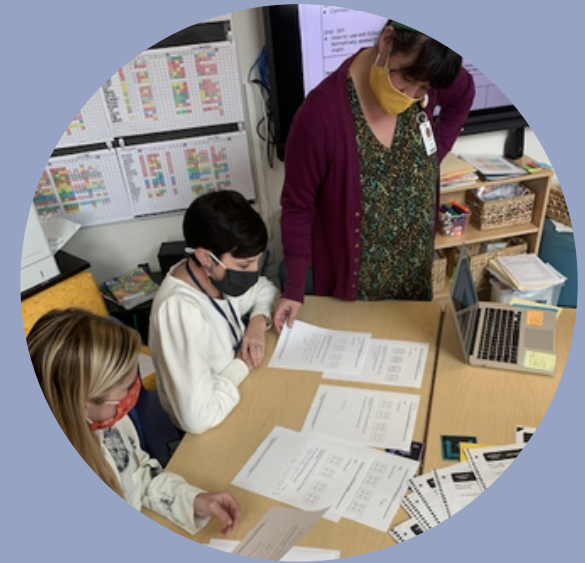
Student Achievement
