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Information on PASS

PASS stands for Palmetto Assessment of State Standards and is the state's testing program, specifically for South Carolina students. PASS is aligned to the state academic standards and includes tests in writing, language arts, math, science and social studies. A student can receive a score of Not Met, Met, or Exemplary on each area tested. Students who receive a "not Met" score did not meet the standard for the area. Students who receive a "MET" score mastered the work tested for that area and compares favorably with children across the nation. Students who receive an "EXEMPLARY" score rated very high on work tested for the area. PASS is based on South Carolina standards that are similar to standards in other states.

- Developed a master schedule that supports daily sharing, collaboration and planning among grade levels.
- Used Voyager Reading for target students

Performance Goal 2: 90% of students in grades 3-5 will score Met or Exemplary in mathematics on the PASS.
