Some key goals the School Improvement Council focused on in the School Renewal Plan included raising the amount of students meeting state standards in all core subject areas. We compared our SC Ready data to the previous year's data and determined that an area of focus is writing. Teachers have received additional training on text dependent analysis writing responses to assist in this area. We use Lexia and DreamBox for digital resources in reading and math. We continue with the personalized learning model to meet the needs of every student. Also, as a Title I school we purchased an additional interventionist to assist with small group instruction in math and reading in grades K-5th.

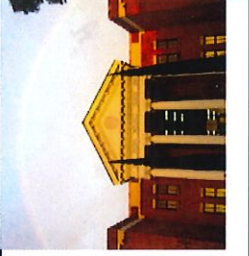
