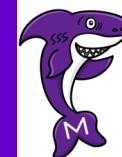

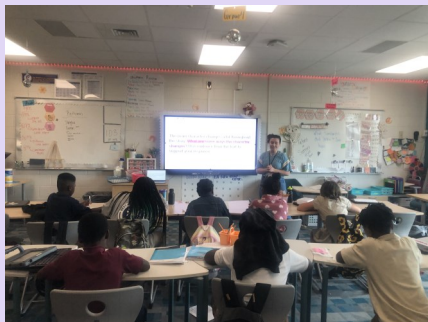
Our SIC Planning Cycle
