

Students take exploratory classes where they have a choice of band, chorus, orchestra, creative writing, PE/fitness, digital literacy, multimedia, Google Basics, Spanish/world cultures, and several Gateway to Technology courses including: Medical Detectives, Flight and Space, Green Architecture, and Automation and Robotics. 
Awards and Accomplishments
