

Academic Progress (MAP)




This table shows the percentages of students who scored at or above the 25th percentile in Reading and Math during the 2013-2014 school year on MAP.

MLES Priorities

Primary Grades Academy

In conjunction with the core reading program, Murray LaSaine Elementary provides additional reading support through Primary Grades Academy (PGA).

This program serves students that are in grades K-3.

MLES provides a multi-tiered intervention system in which students are provided with evidenced-based classroom reading instruction and research based supplemental intervention.

Physical Education/Health & Wellness

Our school participates in a "Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Grant" which has helped us to promote a healthy school environment. This grant provides fresh food choices for our students, often increasing their intake of healthy fruit and vegetables. It also exposes students to a variety of produce they may not have tried before, hopefully expanding their knowledge and interest in healthy living choices. Students also participate in various activities to promote physical health. This year students participate in the following: SC Walk to School Day, Fitness Club, CCPR Swimming Lessons, Jump Rope for Heart, MLES Field Day, PTA Field Day, and daily morning exercises.
