




MAP Summary:

Primary Grades Academy

In conjunction with the core reading program, Murray LaSaine Elementary provides additional reading support through Primary Grades Academy (PGA). This program serves students that are in grades K-3. MLES provides a multi-tiered intervention system in which students are provided with evidenced-based classroom reading instruction and research based supplemental intervention.

Literacy Reading Challenge

Students at MLES have been motivated to exceed Dr. McGinley's challenge of reading a minimum 25 books a year. A new goal, initiated by Megan Pinckney, Miss SC, became their focus. She spoke to our students about the importance of reading and challenged them even more.

Business Partnerships

We partner with several local businesses and community organizations to provide supportive structures and experiences that enhance the lives of our students and the school community, JICP—Learn To Swim Program is one of our newest ventures.

South Carolina's Amazing Coast Program

Selected to participate in an initiative funded by the Center for Ocean Science Education Excellence – South East (CoSEE) The program targets grades 3-5 with the goal of engaging students in science through innovative coastal-based science lessons, student-action projects, investigative field experiences along with interactions with local scientist.
