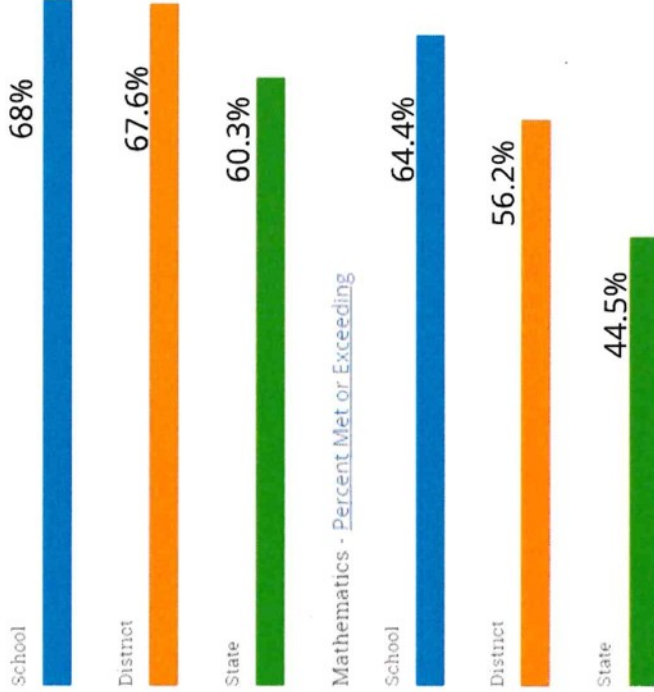

SIC Goals

SC READY ELA From June 2022 to June 2028, increase the percent of students scoring Meets or Exceeds on SC Ready ELA from 61.1% to 68.9% for all students.

- **Action:** Implement a standards-based curriculum at all grade levels that supports the **SC Profile of a Graduate**.
- **Progress towards goal:** 74.7% of all third through fifth grade students are projected to score Meets or Exceeds on ELA SCReady in May of 2026. (Based on Spring 2026 iready data.)



At Oakland Elementary School, we make data-driven decisions that benefit students and work vigorously to ensure that all of our students receive a high quality education. A student success team (MTSS – Multi-Tier Systems of Support) meets weekly to address student needs. iready reports, FastBridge reports, and a variety of other data are utilized to identify students that need assistance to reach their maximum potential. Interventions are incorporated into student schedules and we monitor student progress to ensure that the interventions are yielding desired results.
