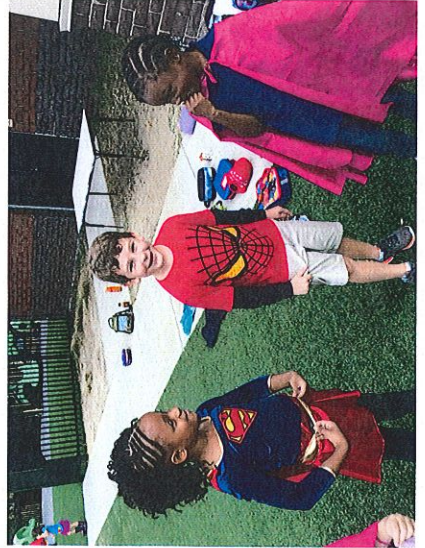

STATE ACCOUNTABILITY

Each year, the S.C. Department of Education issues Report Cards to district and schools as required by the Education Accountability Act of 1988. Districts and schools receive two ratings, one for absolute performance and one for growth rate. The five rating terms are Excellent, Good, Average, Below Average, and At-Risk. St. Andrew's School of Math and Science received an absolute rating of Excellent on the school report.

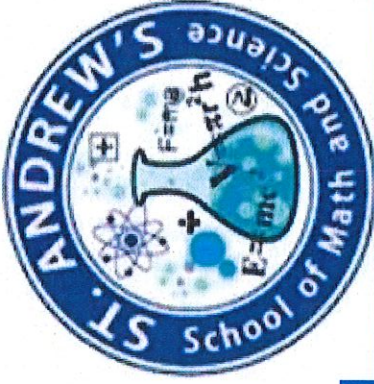

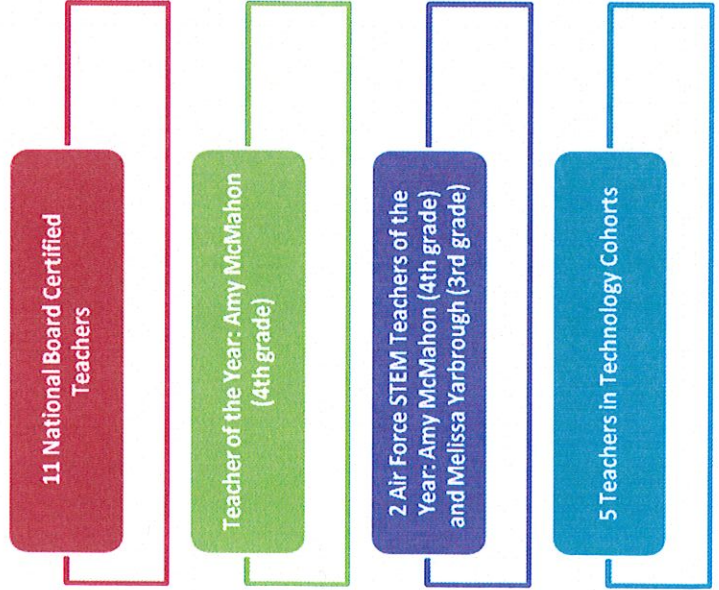
