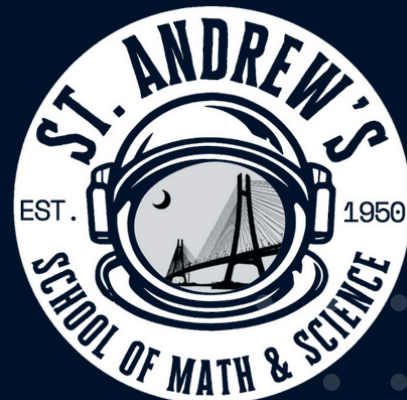

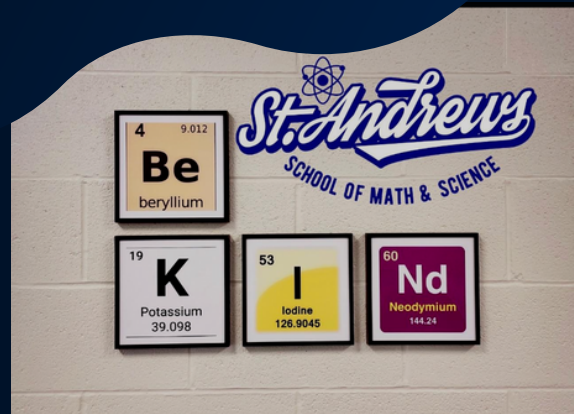

 - 5th grade – 3 days/2 nights at Camp St. Christopher

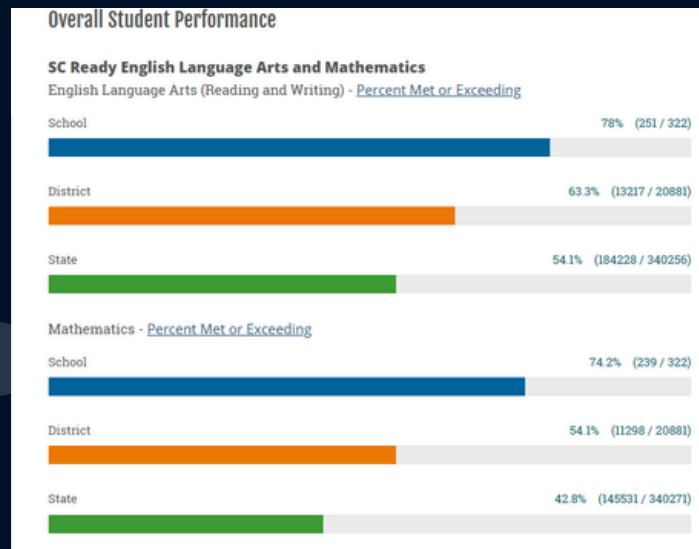
