

2022-23 School Improvement Council Annual Report to Parents and Community

This report is issued by the Angel Oak Elementary School Improvement Council (SIC) in accordance with South Carolina law to share information on the school's progress in meeting various goals and objectives, the work of the SIC, and other accomplishments during the school year.

School Highlights for 2022-23

- Owlventure Camp Summer 2022 was a success! Overall, 82% of students in Reading and 86% of students in Math (grades 2-4) maintained or grew their MAP score achievement from Spring to Summer 2022. Over 90% of CD-1st grade students also grew in their Fastbridge test achievement over this same period. Attendance rates for our summer program were also remarkably high!
- The Charleston Teacher Alliance named Angel Oak Elementary as a "Leadership Honor Roll School" based on their Spring 2022 survey. We were one of only twelve schools in the entire district to earn this recognition.
- The number of AOE students meeting or exceeding expectations on the state's SC Ready and SC PASS test has increased in ELA/Reading by 20.5% since 2016. Math scores have increased by 28.3%. Science scores have increased by 13.7%. Huge growth!
- School Climate survey results from Spring 2022 were positive with 71% of students, 76% of staff and 77% of teachers rating the overall school climate as positive. These were some of the best results in the district!
- Our school counselors received a grant and have built a sensory wall for our school.
 They are also working on a sensory room in the library.

- Angel Oak Elementary is an ArtsNow
 Leadership School. As a part of the SmART
 Literacy federal grant, Angel Oak
 Elementary continues to show growth in
 student achievement each year in the areas
 of reading and writing as reflected by
 increased proficiency in SC READY data,
 Lexile scores and pre/post writing
 assessments as noted in the grant's Year 4
 evaluation snapshot.
- Our Hispanic Heritage Month Celebration was fantastic! We had over three hundred guests attend from our school and Mt. Zion ES to enjoy activities, music, dancing and more.
- Angel Oak Elementary is an ABC School!

- Our PTA continues to shine! - Our students exceeded the school wide goal for our Read-A-Thon. They also raised over \$20,342 for our PTA! We were also able to read as a school during our "One School, One Book" project.
- Our Arts Partners continue to support learning at our school. Thank you to the Palmetto City Ballet, Charleston Jazz, Charleston Symphony Orchestra, The Galliard Center, The Children's Museum, YoArt, ArtsNow, Arts Etc. and the College of Charleston for the wonderful residencies and performances!
- Field trips were possible again this year!
 Our students visited places like the Gaillard
 Center, Caw Caw Interpretive Center,
 Expedition Hanahan, the Gibbes Museum
 and more.
- We have a Career Day, Spring Book Fair,
 Talent Show, a Strings and Chorus concert,
 a Drama Kids performance, Field Days, and
 5th Grade Promotion coming soon to finish
