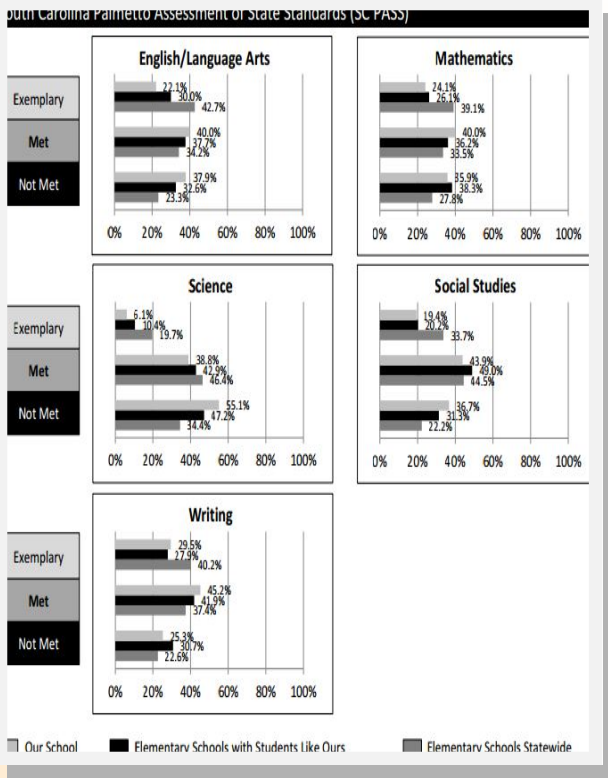

What is Arts Infusion?

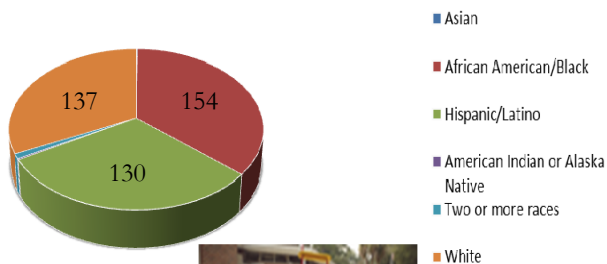
