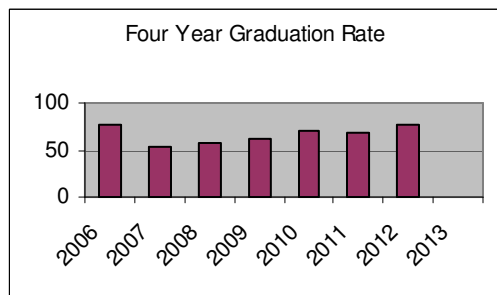


WSHS Celebrations
