Academic & Extra-Curricular Accomplishments

Students have many opportunities to enhance their learning through a variety of extra-curricular activities here at Wagener-Salley High School. From athletics to academic clubs to just for fun clubs, there is something for every student to explore and find his or her niche.



- WSHS seniors received \$659,000 in scholarships last year!
- Seventeen Wagener-Salley seniors were eligible for Life Scholarships and twenty Wagener-Salley seniors eligible for Hope Scholarships.
- Twenty-three seniors graduated with honors!
- Kayla Gallop, Tristan Nisbet and Bryson Shealey were selected to attend, and graduated, the 2016 Junior Leadership Aiken County Program. They raised over \$1700 for Helping Hands.

Army JROTC >>>

- Cadets continue to host an array of school events such as Military Appreciation Night, Veterans Day Program, Military Ball, Palmetto Pride Litter Free Game, and the Black History Program.
- COL Maxie L. Joye and CSM Michael Fowler were selected to serve as the Commandant and Camp Command Sergeant Major for one of the largest JROTC Cadet Leadership Challenges (JROTC summer camp) in the nation at Fort Jackson, SC.
- The WSHS Rifle Team continues to excel by finishing 2nd overall
