WSHS Freshman Academy >>>

The purpose of the Wagener-Salley High School Freshman Academy is to encourage student success by helping to facilitate a smooth transition from middle school to high school, provide a structured atmosphere conducive to learning, and establish high expectations for all students in the academy. The academy includes teachers in the core academic subjects: English, math, science and social studies.

Ways the Freshman Academy Assists Students:

- Teaches students organization, planning and time management skills.
- FA teachers & guidance meet together weekly to discuss overall student progress; parents are often asked to attend these meetings to talk about their child's progress.
