














At Stiles Point, we are deeply committed to cultivating strong literacy skills and fostering a lifelong love of reading in every student. Through intentional instruction, engaging literacy events, and access to diverse, high-quality books, we aim to spark curiosity and imagination while building foundational reading abilities. From early guided reading groups to independent book clubs and school-wide initiatives like Read Across America and Family Literacy Night, our focus remains on making

reading both meaningful and enjoyable. We work closely to ensure that every child finds joy in stories, confidence in their skills, and motivation to grow as a reader.

In addition to our emphasis on literacy, we prioritize excellence in math, science, and social studies by offering students hands-on, inquiry-based learning experiences that build critical thinking and real-world problem-solving skills. Our math instruction encourages conceptual understanding and mathematical reasoning through the use of manipulatives, visual models, and daily opportunities for collaborative practice.
