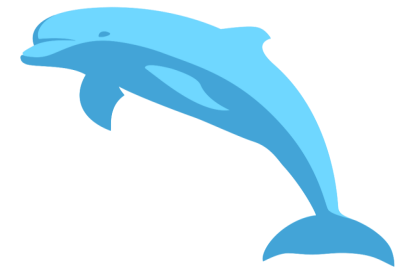
### Purpose of Report

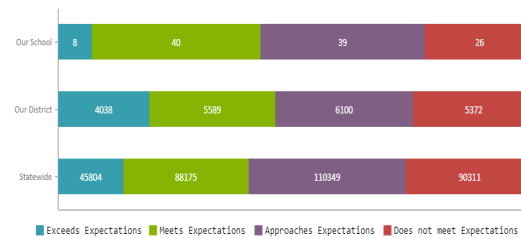

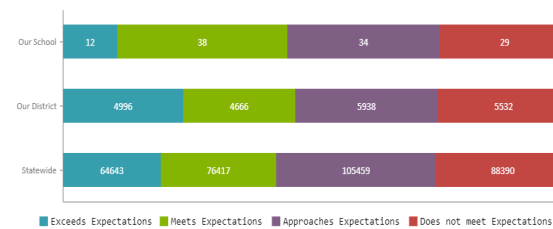

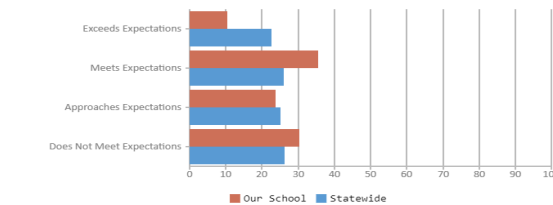
### English



### Mathematics



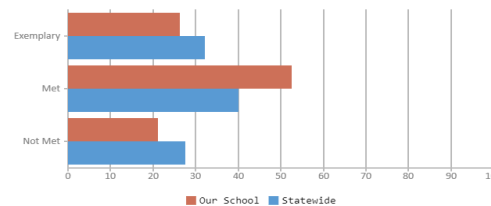
### Science

## Additional Information

Our school is helping all students develop the world class skills and life and career characteristics of the Profile of the South Carolina Graduate by making standards based teaching the top priority. Moving more students to proficient and advanced levels, literacy improvement and teacher quality have been our other key initiatives.

Stono Park staff continues to grow professionally to refine their teaching practices. The faculty participates in Teacher Curriculum Team meetings, monthly faculty meetings and professional development sessions. Standards-based instruction delivered by high performing teachers serves as the foundation of our core work. The school earned an Absolute Rating of **Good** based on the most recent state report card results. Stono Park also met ESEA objectives with an overall grade of "A".
