JBE leaders have much to Celebrate! Academic Mastery Global Leadership

JBE students made great strides toward meeting our School Renewal Plan goals.

The percent of Kindergarten students ending the year at an independent reading level of 3 or higher increased from 86.9% ('16-'17) to 92% ('17- '18) The percent of all JBE students who made *at least* a year's growth on MAP reading went from 53.4% ('16-'17) to 62.3% ('17- '18).

Grade level highlights:

The percent of 2nd grade students meeting their MAP reading goal went from 29.8% ('16-'17) to 51% ('17- '18)!

The percent of 4th grade students meeting their MAP reading goal went from 49.5% ('16-'17) to 53% ('17- '18)!

The percent of 5th grade students meeting their MAP reading goal went from 52.9% ('16-'17) to 66% ('17- '18)!

The percent of all JBE students who met their MAP math goal went up as well!

Grade level highlights:

The percent of Kindergarten students meeting their MAP math goal went from 40% ('16-'17) to 71% ('17- '18)!

The percent of 1st grade students meeting their MAP math goal went from 78.2% ('16-'17) to 82% ('16-'18)! JBE students are developing leadership skills to make the world a better place.
