School Renewal Plan Goals/Supporting Activities

Student Achievement:

- By Spring 2013, 80% of students will score at the met or exemplary level in the four core areas of PASS
- By Spring 2013, 65% of students will score at/above the District grade level mean RIT in Reading & Math on MAP
