SIC YEAR IN SUMMARY

Another quality endeavor for the SIC was the topic of bullying. Bullying can be catastrophic to children if left unaddressed or if it is continuous. The question was asked, "How do Kennedy Middle School students report bullying for themselves or for another student?" A small taskforce tackled this topic and some ideas were recommended such as a digital bullying report form AND a bullying campaign that would provide education to both students and parents about what bullying actually is and how to stop it. Likewise, the SIC developed a first-time partnership with an organization called Bikers Against Bullying out of Beaufort, South Carolina. It is the hopes of the KMS SIC to have this group visit the school in the future!
