2014-2015 General Information:

Kennedy Middle School is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS)

School Population – 902 students with a student attendance rate of 96.4%.

Kennedy Middle School received an $\underline{\mathbf{B}}$ rating from the Federal Elementary and Secondary Act (ESEA) grading system Structured reading time held school-wide daily for 20 minutes.

Shana Pearsons (7th grade Science teacher) was selected as our 2015 teacher of the year.

Matthew Kennamer (7th grade Social Studies teacher) was selected as our 2015 1st year teacher of the year.
