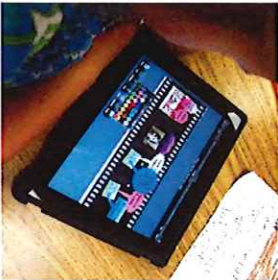


School Activities & Involvement
