


#### SIC Annual Goals

Laurel Hill continues to make great strides in the school and community through the partnership between the School Improvement Council and PTA. We hosted our first ever Color Run, which raised over \$90,000 for the school. Those funds were used to refurbish our Turtle Trail Playground, purchase new rugs for classrooms, and fund teacher positions which were used to improve student outcomes. We also hosted several spirit nights with our Partners in Education, and are looking forward to our annual Turtle Trot and Spring Carnival in May. The SIC was instrumental in preparing for our NAEYC Accreditation Renewal, and we are confident the accreditation will be renewed for another 5 years. Our SIC will also host a community blood drive through a partnership with the American Red Cross.

At Laurel Hill, our mission is to develop well-rounded learners in a child-centered, developmentally appropriate environment where each student is capable of fulfilling their potential.

#### K iReady Math


87% of our kindergarten students are early, mid, or above grade level based on the Kindergarten iReady Spring Diagnostic.


#### 1st Grade iReady Math

### Summary of Data

Our data highlights the hard work of our staff and students. Our students continue to meet both growth and achievement expectations in both reading and math. Through ESSER supported positions, we are able to add staff members that provided targeted intervention to students who need individualized support. ESSER funds also allowed us to provide extensive professional development opportunities for our staff in both reading and math. Our team uses data to drive instruction in order to meet the needs of all students. At the spring diagnostic, students scoring "Early On Grade Level" are scoring with their current grade level range for the assessment. Students scoring "Mid or Above Grade Level" have met or exceeded the end of year goal on the assessment.


