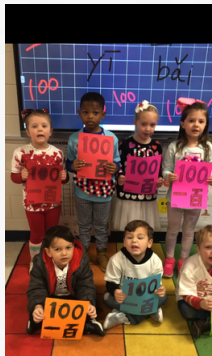
# House Model
