
## MISSION STATEMENT

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS**

- \*The Graduation rate for the BHS Class of 2020 was 83.1% with \$5,097,304 in scholarships.
- \*Our Varsity Football Team performed well under difficult circumstances this year. We had four All-Region selections: Matt Davis, Jeremiah Foster, Dustin Rising, and Ty Wilson.
- \*Our Varsity Girls' Basketball Team excelled this season. Our Lady 'Cats were the Region 2 2A Champions and Upper State 2A Runner up. Mikayla Logan was named to the 2A All-State Team as well as Region Player of the Year. Mikayla Logan, Essence Caviness, and Atia Tate were All Region Players. Bobby Rodgers was named Coach of the Year.
- \*Ty Wilson was selected for the Boys' Basketball All-Region Team.
- \*Jackson Lipe was named to the All-State Clinic Band. Jacob Coughlin, Payton Moore, and Bradley Coffee achieved Region Six Honor Band status.
- \*Mrs. Monica Martin was selected by her peers as Teacher of the Year and Mrs. Tamara Davis was chosen as our Support Staff of the Year. Mr. Douglas Blackburn was awarded the CRC Distinguished Teacher of Reading.

#### **UPDATED ACTIVITIES**

\*We will have 14 graduating AVID Seniors this year with a total AVID enrollment of 87 students. Thirteen AVID seniors have received college acceptance letters and one student will enter the National Guard. Our data reports show that AVID students consistently score higher on EOC exams than non-AVID students.

\*BHS continues to maintain in-depth Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) and Response to Intervention (RtI) programs to assist emerging students to succeed in the classroom both academically and behaviorally.
