## **Updated Activities**

- 1. Continue the implementation of a comprehensive guidance plan and the academic curriculum guides to meet the needs of our students.
- 2. Continue Response to Intervention (RtI) which is designed to help struggling students in the classroom. RtI is a district wide policy to offer students additional help to succeed in the classroom both academically and behaviorally. This process is independent of special education and is not designed to replace that process; it is to help all students across the board perform to their best ability.
- 3. Continue to implement the High Schools That Work (HSTW) program to insure that all students are receiving a rigorous and relevant curriculum.
- 4. Continue to implement Common Core State Standards, including revising lessons to reflect CCSS tasks and assessments such as Performance Tasks.
- 5. Promote a literary partnership with Blacksburg Primary School and Blacksburg Elementary School.

## **Updated Needs Assessment**

- 1. Provide a safe and secured campus for students and staff.
- 2. Develop a positive Public Relations system for communicating successes and needs to parents and the community, as well as creating a positive brand for BHS.
- 3. Teach soft skills such as communication, conflict resolution, and interview skills.

## **School Community Achievements**

- 1. Blacksburg High School earned an absolute rating of **Excellent** on our 2013 South Carolina State Department Report Card and a growth rating of Average.
- 2. The graduation rate for the BHS Senior Class of 2013 was 84.6 %.
- 3. The 2013 HSAP pass rate for first time HSAP test takers was 90.8 % on the High School Assessment Program (HSAP) test.
- 4. The 2013 HSAP pass rate for second year students passing two subtests on HSAP was 84.3 %.

- 6. Several BHS students were awarded basketball awards for our region. Jasmine Dameron, Shalesa Degree, Daquan McNeil, and Montavious Rogers won spots on the All-Area Basketball Team. We also had four students chosen for the Basketball All-Academic Team: Ally McCurry, Shanna Ramsey, Nicholas Dixon, and Tanner Smith. Jasmine Dameron was also selected as All-State.
- 7. The Blacksburg High School Wildcat Marching Band placed third in Upper State Competition this year. The Marching Band went on to place 3<sup>rd</sup> in the State Competition. Nicholas Dixon & Alex Hampton were invited to the Winthrop Invitational Band Clinic and the following were participants in the Limestone Honor Band Clinic: Nicholas Dixon, Maya Ferguson, Alex Hampton, Bailey Pierce, Maria Prizzi, Abigail Sanlin, and Tori Turner.
