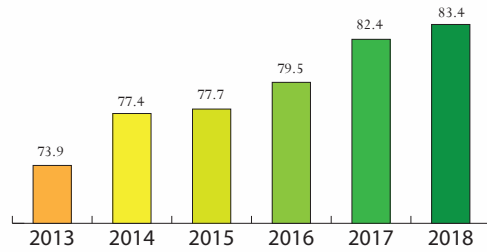

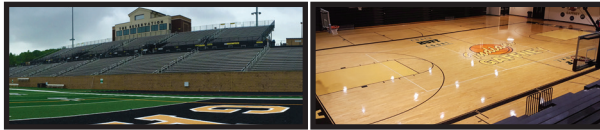

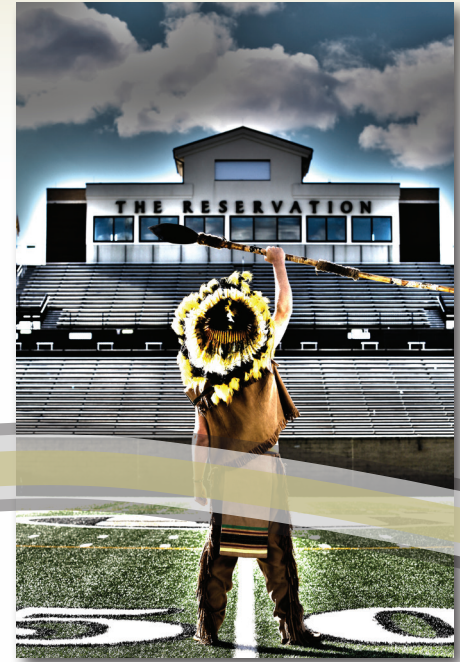


Renaissance A Journey to Academic Excellence
