This has been a very successful year at Granard Middle School. Our teachers and staff worked diligently to provide a nurturing and academically challenging environment. We had 22 Junior Scholars (up from 14 in 2010 and 9 in 2009), numerous writing award winners, Regional and State Band awards, as well as successful seasons in football, volleyball, and basketball. Our School Report Card scores improved and we met Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) based on 2009-2010 PASS scores! Students and staff participated in Writing Across the Curriculum. This was a tremendous success. We continued to stress technology implementation in the classrooms, and held school-based training sessions for electronic white boards, classroom performance systems (CPS), LCD projectors, ETV and document cameras.
